



UP TO \$10 MILLION REWARD

Sayf al-Adl and **Abdullah Ahmed Abdullah** were charged by a federal grand jury and are under indictment for their role in the August 7, 1998 bombings of the U.S. embassies in Dar es Salaam, Tanzania and Nairobi, Kenya. The attacks killed 224 civilians, including 12 Americans, and wounded over 5,000 others.

Both al-Qa'ida senior leaders are members of al-Qa'ida's leadership council. Al-Adl heads al-Qa'ida's military committee and Abdullah is an experienced trainer and operational planner for al-Qa'ida.
