Tahil Sali and Ahadon Adak are commanders in the Moro National Liberation Front (MNLF). On September 29, 2009 on Jolo Island, Philippines, an MNLF-placed explosive device blew up a convoy of military vehicles. The blast killed two U.S. Army soldiers and an Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) soldier, who were part of a humanitarian mission to construct a school in the area. On May 21, 2010, the Philippine 9th Judicial Region issued Warrants of Arrest for Sali and Adak for the attack.

The U.S. government is offering rewards for information that leads to the arrest of these individuals. Absolute confidentiality is assured and relocation may be available. If you have information, please contact the nearest U. S. embassy or consulate or info@rewardsforjustice.net.
